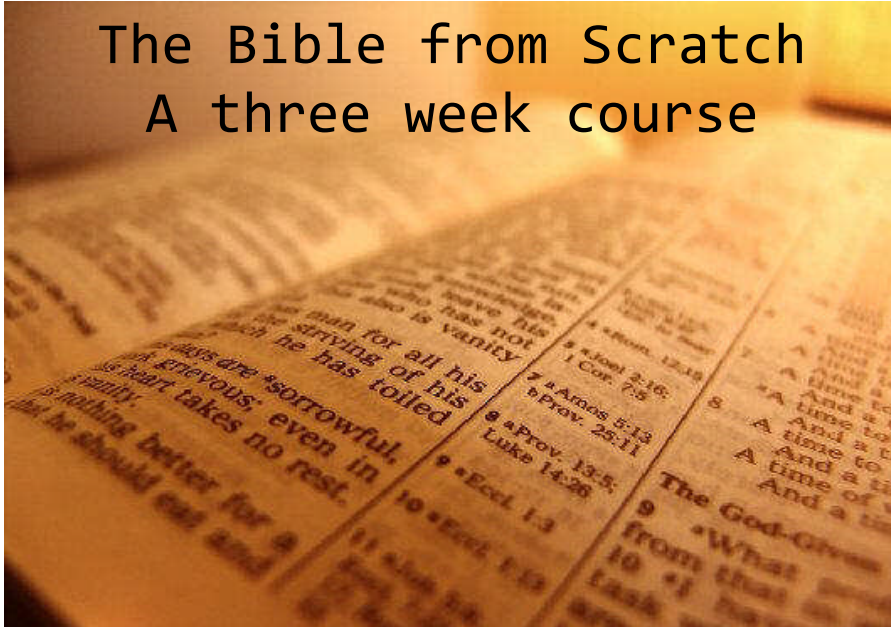


# The Bible from Scratch
