

Sunday mornings at 8am

Holy Communion (said, from the Book of Common Prayer) is celebrated, in the south aisle. The congregation numbers 12-25.

There is a short homily and the service lasts about 40 minutes.

Sunday mornings at 10am

All-age Communion involves the youth choir together with the parish choir; children remain in church for the whole service (which lasts about an hour).

Sung Eucharist involves the New Voices choir who usually sing a setting of the service and Introit and Communion anthems. The service may last 75 minutes. Junior Church has groups from the crèche to the Why group (up to teens); they usually join the congregation for Communion.

Family Service involves the youth choir (and sometimes a music group); children remain in church for the whole service (which lasts about 45 minutes).

Parish Communion involves the parish choir. Junior Church groups meet in the Hall. The service (which lasts about 60-70 minutes) is followed by prayers for healing (H), in the chancel, on 4th Sundays.

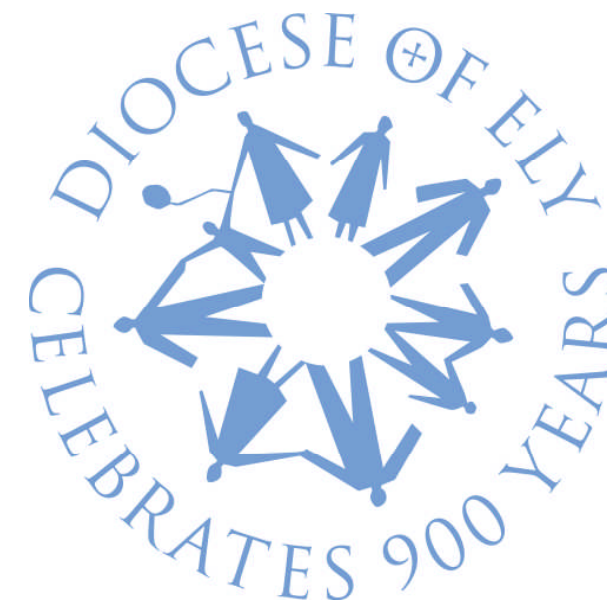
