The war memorial

Date: 1920

The war memorial is made of Scottish grey granite and is 16 feet high. It was unveiled on 25 September 1920 by Mrs Rosalind Clark who lived in the Manor House. Her only son, Anthony, is among those commemorated. Thousands filled the recreation ground for a service led by the Bishop of Ely before the crowds processed to the churchyard. The names of those who died in the Second World War were added in 1994.
