### Volunteer this Winter with the CCHP!

The Cambridge Churches Homeless Project works together with Jimmy's and other service providers and runs from December to March in eight churches and one synagogue, one venue for each night of the week. We take turns to provide a friendly welcome, hot supper, and safe space to sleep to up to 15 homeless guests. Volunteers act as hosts each night, and the scheme is joined up by a core team of support workers who offer pastoral care and links to further help.
