Lent at St Andrew's

There will be four strands to our observance of Lent this year:

Through Lent with Luke. During Lent we will be reading through Luke's account of the journey to Jerusalem (from 9.51). We are encouraging the reading of a portion of the narrative during each week (see below) and will be including passages from these in our morning and evening services. Lent groups on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings and Thursday afternoons will give the opportunity to share what we have been learning. There will be an introduction to the whole sequence during our Ash Wednesday services (13 February, 12.15pm and 7.30pm).

Week 1: 9.51-11.53

Week 2: 12.1-13.9

Week 3: 13.10-14.34

Week 4: 15.1-17.19

Week 5: 17.20-19.27

Week 6 (Holy week): 19.28-23.56

Week 7 (Easter week): 24.1-53

Our **evening services** during Lent will be at 6pm in the chancel (either a Taizé service or a Contemplative Communion) - both at 10am and 6pm we will be reading part of Luke's narrative.

There will be two **days of prayer** when you are invited to fill an hour's slot in a chain of prayer in church. The first will be on Ash Wednesday. You can fill in a slot online via the church website or on the notice-board at the back.

During Lent there will also be another opportunity to join a **prayer triplet**. More details later, but you can let John Reynolds know if you'd like to take part.
