

Sunday mornings at 8am

Holy Communion (said, from the Book of Common Prayer) is celebrated in the south aisle. The service lasts about 40 mins.

Sunday mornings at 10am

All-age Communion involves the youth choir together with the Parish Choir; children remain in church for the whole service (which lasts just over an hour).

Sung Eucharist involves the New Voices choir who usually sing a setting of the service and Introit and Communion anthems. The service may last 75 minutes. Junior Church is in the Hall.

Family Service involves the youth choir (and sometimes a music group); children remain in church for the whole service (which lasts about 45 minutes).

Parish Communion (which lasts about 60-70 minutes) involves the parish choir but extra singers are welcome (come to a rehearsal at 9.30am on the day). Junior Church is in the Hall.

Prayer for healing is offered at all 10am Communions (except major Festivals).
