

## Sunday mornings at 8am

**Holy Communion** (said, from the Book of Common Prayer) is celebrated in the south aisle. The service lasts about 40 mins.

## Sunday mornings at 10am

**All-age Communion** involves the youth choir together with the parish choir; children remain in church for the whole service (which lasts just over an hour).

**Sung Eucharist** involves the New Voices choir who usually sing a setting of the service and Introit and Communion anthems. The service may last 75 minutes. Junior Church is in the Hall.

**Family Service** involves the youth choir (and, sometimes, a music group); children remain in church for the whole service (which lasts about 45 minutes).

**Parish Communion** (which lasts about 60-70 minutes) involves the parish choir but extra singers are welcome (come to a rehearsal at 9.30am on the day). Junior Church is in the Hall.

**Prayer for healing** is offered at all 10am Communions (except major Festivals).
