Recruiting residents for Lyn's House, Cambridge

Are you a student, recent graduate or a young adult looking for a place to live?

Live in Cambridge as part of a small, praying, ecumenical Christian community and share in a ministry of friendship centred on adults with intellectual disabilities, supported by volunteers and trustees within the wider Lyn's House community.

Places are available from the end of August for the academic year 2021-22 in a shared, 3-bedroom house with a communal lounge, with a large orchard and gardens. The house is situated on Grange Road, a quiet street close to the city centre.

Monthly rents range from £564 to £620. This includes all utilities, WIFI, use of shared lounge and outdoor space, and a weekly clean of communal areas. Council tax is not charged to residents. Limited grants may be available to assist with rent costs where applicants can demonstrate genuine need.
